Description

This compact shrub will add a bright spot of glowing yellow color to your landscape during the winter months. The stems turn bright yellow in the winter and look like winter sunshine against the white snow. The stems can be cut to create gorgeous outdoor planters and holiday decorations. Arctic Fire Dogwood is native to North America. Clusters of white flowers form on last year's stem in the spring. The flowers produce white berries that are quickly eaten by birds soon after ripening. The flowers are attractive to butterflies and hummingbirds.
