### **Description**

*Nassella tenuissima*, commonly called Mexican Feather Grass is the most fine-textured grass we can grow. With its wispy, flowing, lime-green foliage, the slightest breeze will cause it to sway. This cool-season native grass retains its color year round, although it may brown out somewhat in the heat of the summer. Light, wheat-colored seed heads emerge in May. Self-sowing can occur, so it's best used in managed landscapes where spreading can be controlled. Mexican Feather Grass requires dry soil and full sun, and it is very drought tolerant. *Nassella tenuissima* is especially spectacular planted in decorative containers. Suitable for mass plantings and erosion control.
