Description

Ginger Wine Ninebark is an easy to care, native flowering shrub. Spring foliage emerges in a sunny orange color and matures to sparkling burgundy. Clusters of spirea-like white flowers cover the plant in late spring that give rise to attractive red seed heads. This disease-resistant shrub does best in full sun locations and cooler climates. Blooms on old wood, so if necessary prune after flowering.
