Description

Rodgersia pinnata is a bold, rhizomatous perennial with pinnately compound, basal leaves which appear palmate. Named Bronze Peacock because of the way the new growth emerges and spreads like a Peacock's tail. Valued for its foliage, it has palmately compound to pseudo-pinnate, thick, shiny, basal leaves that emerge dark bronze in spring and mature to green with dark edges. During the summer, it has clusters of apetalous, tiny pink flowers on branched red stems that are up to 4 ft. tall. Attracts pollinators. Good in mass or group plantings in moist woodland or bog gardens or in wet areas along stream or ponds. Makes an understory accent plant or impressive specimen in the dappled shade.
